Moses' Passion for God and Love for People
Exodus 19–40

Throughout this section of Exodus (chapters 19-40) we see several themes—giving of the Law, confirmation of the Covenant, regulations regarding the Tabernacle, and the Priesthood. There is also a fascinating historical interlude tucked in the middle of the narrative that describes the events surrounding the golden calf episode, the tablets of stone, and Moses experiencing God's Presence.

Read Exodus chapters 32-34 carefully and then answer the following questions:

What significant events from the Israelite's national history are described in these chapters?

What themes can you identify regarding:

-The Israelites relationship with God and their response to Him?

-Moses' relationship with God and with the Israelites?

Are you reflect on Moses' passion for God and His holiness, and Moses' love for his fellow Israelites, what does this teach you about God?

What does it teach you about yourself and your personal relationship with God?

Read Exodus 17:1-7; Numbers 20:1-13

What do these passages describe? How are the situations similar? How are they different?

Why do you think God's instructions to Moses were different in the two situations? How did Moses respond to each circumstance, and what were the results for Moses personally?

What does this teach about your obedience and reverence toward God?
